WHAT IS THE EDUCATION PROJECT?

The Education Project works to ensure students in homelessness and temporary living situations enroll, regularly attend and succeed in school. During the 2019-2020 school year, we served more than 1,000 students in Washtenaw County, ages 0-21, from the nine school districts and 13 public school academies in the county. Every single school district in the county is working with students in temporary living situations.

The federal McKinney-Vento Act considers individuals who lack a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence as homeless. This includes students living in the following situations: Emergency shelters transitional housing, motels or hotels, unsheltered or in substandard housing, shared housing due to a loss of housing, economic hardship, safety concern, etc., living temporarily with a non-parent or guardian.
